About the competition

Once again, the LASH DESIGNER of the Year international online lash competition will be held!

In recent years, the focus has been on precision, professional dedication, and a cross-category challenge. This year will be no different—and of course, we've brought some exciting new updates for the 2025 edition ©

The theme of this year's competition is: **Black Swan with Color Effect**

– this must be reflected in every category.

In the lash categories, the complete set must consist of **2/3 black and 1/3 colored lashes**.

In the lifting and brow categories, the same ratio of coloring must be applied to the lashes and brows.

In the makeup category, the makeup look must contain **2/3 black and 1/3 color** (one or more colors).

In 2025, we will once again award the title of **Ultimate Lash Master!**

Only a carefully selected panel of highly qualified professional judges will be seeking the most outstanding lash stylists—those who distinguish themselves through precision, sense of style, and creativity, earning the prestigious title of Lash Artist of the Year.

The core value of this competition is **perfection**, which is not just an expectation but a **baseline requirement**.

This kind of perfection stands in contrast to mass-produced, cheap work and reveals itself through **conscientious precision**, full consideration of the model's unique features, and a **naturally captivating look**.

"Perfection is not always obvious, but its absence is immediately noticeable."

Refined frame lines, eye-catching symmetry, and restrained material usage are the marks of a skilled artist. Everything beyond that will determine **who delivers a performance that excels across categories**, thus earning the title of **Ultimate Lash Master**.

Follow the competition, watch for registration deadlines, enter as many categories as you can, and prove that **you are the one** who deserves the

Ultimate Lash Master title! Express Yourself Like No One Else!

Use your signature color palette, play with lashes, your model, makeup, and accessories. Infuse your entry with **vision**, **personal perspective**, and above all — **quality**.

Elevate lash styling to an **art form** and become the ultimate creator!

Show us that **you are the best of the best** — someone who is precise, stylish, and creative all at once!

Own the competition and prove that **you are the true Lash Master!**For the **Ultimate Lash Master** title, you need to apply for these 3 categories (of course you can also apply for more): Classic 1D, Volume 3-5D, Trending Volume.. The winner is the contestant who achieves the **highest total score** across **three categories** (e.g., Classic, Volume 3-5D, Trending Volume Set).

Competition Rules

- Classic Look (2 levels: Rising Star & Elite Artist)
- *Volume 3–5D Look* (2 levels: Rising Star & Elite Artist)
- *Trending Volume Set* (Wet Effect, Eyeliner Effect, Wispy Effect)] (2 levels: Rising Star & Elite Artist)
- CURLX Freestyle Promade Set [Y, W, Pre/Promade, Hybrid, Spike, Anime] (One Level)
- Lash Lifting + Brow Styling (2 levels: Rising Star & Elite Artist)
- *Fantasy Lash Art* (One Level)

*Levels:

- Rising Star: 0-2 Years experience

- Elite Artist: 2+ Years of experience and/or Trainer

Entry Fees

Prizes

The **Top 3 winners in each category** will receive:

The **ULTIMATE LASH MASTER** title winner will receive:

- The Ultimate Lash Master Trophy & Certificate
- A sponsor prize package
- An **invitation to join the jury** for next year's competition!

Conditions

To participate in the competition, the following requirements must be met:

- Acceptance of the Competition Rules and GDPR policy
- The contestant must be a **real person over the age of 18** with a **professional certificate** in lash, brow, or makeup work
- Entries are open to participants from any country
- The contestant must provide all required information truthfully to the organizer, including:

full name, billing address, chosen category, email address, Facebook and Instagram profile links, and their qualification(s) for the selected categories

- A contestant may enter multiple categories, but only one submission per category is allowed
- The entry is only valid if the contestant **fully pays the entry fee** for the selected category or categories via **bank transfer** to the account indicated on the invoice provided by the organizer
- Entry fees are non-refundable, even in the case of incorrect transfers, missed submission, late submission, or if the wrong category or level was selected
- Submissions are only considered valid if they **fully comply** with all rules and technical requirements for each category
- Submissions must **not be shared or published on any media platforms** prior to the official results announcement. Failure to comply will result in **disqualification**, and the entry fee will not be refunded
- Early bird registrations are only considered final once the fee is paid within the promotional timeframe
- Any contestant attempting to **influence the judges** or placing **any identifying hints** in their entry will be **immediately disqualified**
- Any entry that does **not meet the listed criteria** will not be evaluated

Submission Requirements

- Entries must be submitted as image files (JPG/JPEG) without the contestant's name, via a Google Drive folder shared by the organizers in advance
- Photo editing/retouching is strictly prohibited, not just on the eyes, but on the entire photo
- No logos or text overlays are allowed on the photos
- Collaged or montaged photos are not accepted
- Photos must be **close-up shots** with **excellent lighting**, so judges can assess the technical work properly. Otherwise, the entry may receive a **partial score** or not be scored at all
- Red or irritated eyes in the photos will result in point deductions
- Uploading **too many or too few photos** compared to the required number will also result in point deductions
- Contestants must enter at the **correct level** that matches their actual experience

- The **level of professional experience** is calculated from the date when the contestant obtained their certificate for the category, up to the **payment date** of the entry fee
- A contestant may use the same model in multiple categories
- Entries must **not have been published or shared** on any media platform prior to submission. Any violation will result in **disqualification**.
- If you are uncertain about anything and it's not mentioned in the rules, please contact the organizer via the competition's official email address.

Process of Registration

- 1. The contestant submits their **personal information** via the registration form on www.lashdesigneroftheyear.com and selects the category or categories they wish to enter. Registration requires the contestant to **read and accept** the competition rules, data protection policy, and **consent to the use of personal data**.
- 2. The organizer will **review the application** and respond within **48 hours** with a **confirmation email**, which will include the **invoice for the entry fee**.
- 3. The contestant transfers the full amount on the invoice to the provided bank account. In the **payment reference**, they must include their name and the category or categories they are registering for (e.g., "Jane Doe Classic Elite Artist, Volume Rising Star").
- 4. Once the payment is received, the organizer will send the **official invoice** and the **personal Google Drive folder link** for uploading the competition materials.
- 5. The contestant uploads the required **photos** (in JPG/JPEG format) along with their certificate and lash map to the shared folder. The contestant's name must not appear on the checklist or any photo. The date of the first certificate earned in the selected category should be used as the reference date.

Judging

- Each submission is judged by a minimum of 3 judges per category.
- Scores are given in **increments of 0.5**, rounded to whole numbers.
- The **organizer does not participate** in the evaluation of any submissions.
- Entries are submitted with **anonymous numerical codes** to ensure **unbiased judging**. Any attempt to include identifying hints will result in **immediate disqualification**.
- In the case of a tie, the final decision is made by judge vote.
- Judges may offer additional trophies, awards, or gifts at their own discretion.

The organizers reserve the right to make changes.

Deadlines

- Competition Launch: September 1, 2025
- Early Bird Registration Deadline: August 20-31, 2025
- **Submission Deadline:** December 30, 2025 at 18:00 CET
- **Judging Period:** January 3–11, 2026
- **Results Announcement:** January 16, 2026 at 18:00 CET

On the day of the announcement, winners' names and their submitted works will be published. If a contestant wishes to enter the same work in a future competition, they must notify the organizers by email **before** the official results are announced!

- Score Sheets: Will be shared with all contestants as soon as possible after the results. Each contestant can identify their scores using their assigned submission number.
- Shipping of Trophies & Prizes: Begins January 19, 2026
- Sponsor Packages & Special Prizes: Must be submitted by January 15, 2026 so they can be forwarded to winners on time
